

NSW PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE 2018

In 2018, all Year 7 students will participate in the NSW Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) as part of their English wide reading program. The PRC is a reading challenge open to Yrs 7-9 in which the Premier of NSW challenges students to read 20 books from specific reading lists from early March to late August 2018.

All Year 7 English classes will have library time to read, discuss and loan books and update online reading records. The Teacher Librarian is the Co-ordinator of the Challenge and is required to validate participant records in August 2018.

All PRC reading lists, rules, terms and conditions, are available from the NSW Premier's Reading Challenge [website](#) and the [PRC support site](#).

Two conditions of entering the Challenge are that students may receive a certificate and their name may appear on the Gold or Platinum Honour Roll. Certificates have the student's name and school printed on them. The Honour Roll lists student names in the PRC website only. Names are listed in alphabetical order (not by school) and no other identifying features are included.

Students who do not wish to have names published on the Gold or Platinum Honour Roll (or whose parents/carers do not wish them to) should **not** register for the Challenge **online**. They may take part in the Challenge unofficially - they may use the PRC booklists and can seek recognition from RBSC school community – but they cannot add any books to an online Student Reading Record.

Students who complete the Challenge will be invited to an end of year celebration luncheon and movie screening. Students who complete the Challenge for four years receive a gold certificate, seven years a Platinum Certificate and students who complete the Challenge each year from year 3 to year 9 inclusive receive a PRC medal.
